

The Riley Key Memorial Scholarship

The Riley Key Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 2009 in loving memory of Riley Key. Riley, a 2009 graduate of Round Top-Carmine High School, was tragically killed in an automobile accident on June 27, 2009, at the age of 18.



To be eligible for the 2012 Riley Key Memorial Scholarship you must either be registered, or planning to register, for 12 college hours in the fall semester of 2012. Past recipients are not eligible to apply.
